DRINKING WATER STATEMENT

First Steps Together have designated drinking water stations clearly labelled and readily and available for all staff, students and visitors as follows:

Communal Area

First Steps Together are committed to ensuring that drinking water is safe, and a number of checks are undertaken to check the temperature and purity of the water which is readily available for all.

Checks include a Legionella Risk Assessment which is completed by an external contractor, further checks include:

- Monthly temperature recording checks.

Any periods of closure to the school building that exceed 5 days will result in a “tap running” process for a minimum of 3 minutes to every tap in the building which will be conducted by our nominated Health and Safety lead.

Drinking Water taps are clearly marked with signage.
